1. INTRODUCTION TO CREATIVE CAREERS WORKSHOP

A 1-hour workshop and Q&A session discovering a world of creative careers. Our Take Part practitioners will visit your school and bring along tailored resources exploring some of the many career options available within the performing arts industry. Suitable for KS3, 4 & 5.

2. BACKSTAGE TOURS AT SALISBURY PLAYHOUSE


Pupils will see the theatre at work, engage with staff, explore the venue and see how a production is developed on and off stage. Suitable for all Key Stages.

• CREATIVE CAREERS DAY AT SALISBURY PLAYHOUSE 27TH FEB 2024, 9.30AM-2.30PM, £15 PER PUPIL

An opportunity for Key Stage 4 & 5 groups to find out more about the Performing Arts Industry. The day provides a valuable insight into the production process, relevant to all drama students, but is particularly beneficial to students interested in production or a career in live events.

Students will have the opportunity to get hands on by taking part in practical workshops and Q&As led by industry professionals. Workshops have previously included lighting and sound, performance, producing, stage management and costume.

• CREATIVE CAREERS WEEK

WEEK COMMENCING 17TH JUNE 2024, FREE

A deep dive into the world of Wiltshire Creative for a small group of young people aged 14-19 interested in careers in the arts industry. This opportunity is designed to be used as Work Experience. Participants will have the chance to work behind the scenes in our venues and learn about the range of artistic, administrative, and technical roles across the organisation. There is also the chance to obtain a Bronze Arts Award.

Individual applicants should email an expression of interest to takepart@wiltshirecreative.co.uk as early as possible before April 2024. Successful applicants will be informed by the end of May. The email should include their full name and age plus an answer to the question: "Why do you want to take part and how will this opportunity be useful for you in the future?". (Any skills you would like to learn? Any experiences you would like to have?) This can be provided in written format or video.







• DRAMA SCHOOL AUDITION TRAINING DAY MONDAY 23RD OCTOBER, 10AM, FREE

A free workshop at Salisbury Playhouse in October half term for young people who are planning to apply to study for a degree in Drama. Participants will learn what to expect in the application process and work with professionals to get support with audition speeches, ask questions about applications and share experiences with other members of the group.

This training day is led by Tom Sherman. Tom trained at Bristol Old Vic Theatre School and is an actor and director, as well as being our FE Performing and Production Arts Course Leader here at Wiltshire Creative! 


ARTS AWARD & ARTSMARK


