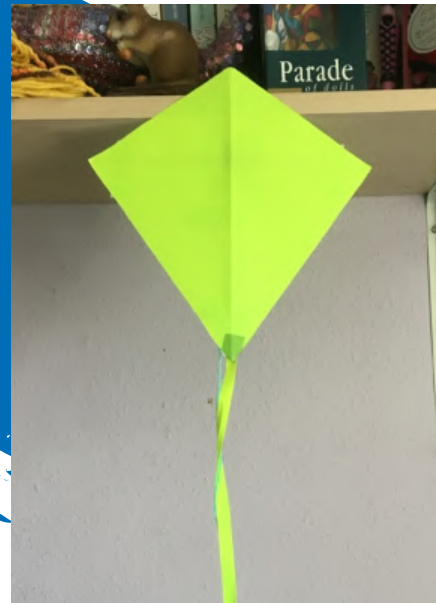


MAKE YOUR OWN KITE

- PAPER
- 2 STICKS (KABAB STEWERS/PLANT STICKS/LOLLY STICKS)
- TAPE
- SCISSORS
- PENCIL
- STRING
- RIBBONS (OPTIONAL)

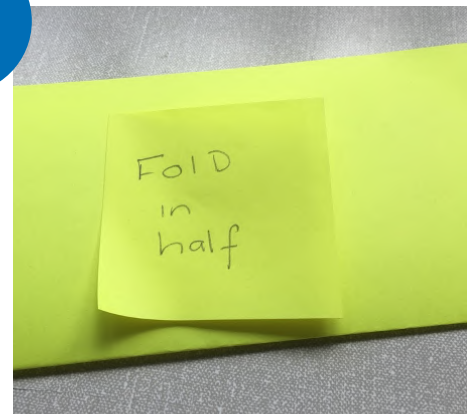

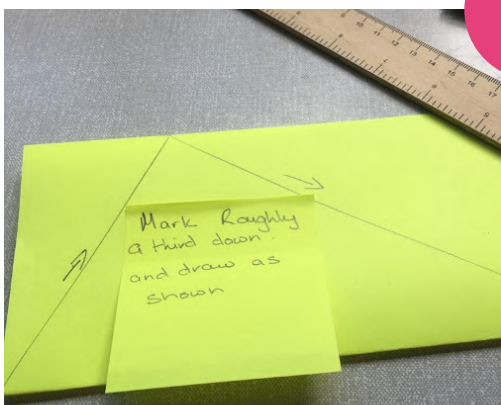
Measure and cut out a 20cm x 20 cm.

Fold your paper in half.

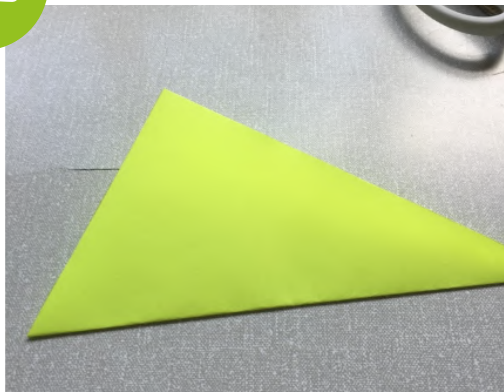
3



Mark roughly a third of the way down the open long edge and draw 2 lines that meet at that point.

1 from each corner on the folded edge.

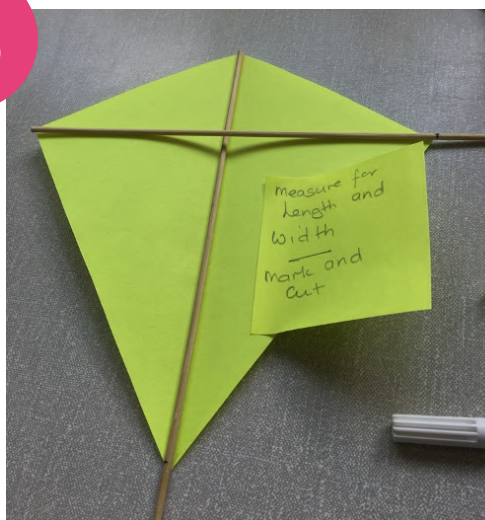
Cut along the two lines.

5



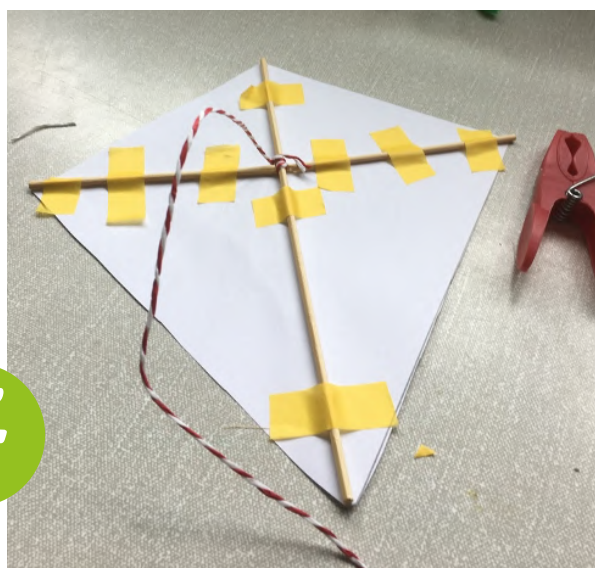
Open up the paper.

Place the sticks along the length and width. Measure and trim the sticks to length.

Tape the sticks to the kite and tie string to the overlap in the centre of the kite.



NOW TAPE OR GLUE RIBBON AND STRING TO THE BASE OF YOUR KITE TO MAKE A TAIL. NOW LET'S GO FLY A KITE!
