Resources

At the beginning of 2021 we embarked on [SHIFT](#); a project designed to amplify young voices through the arts. The newly convened Youth Arts Network Film platformed issues that young people from around the South wanted to get 'off their chest' in their chosen art form. The result was powerful and audience feedback helped shaped its next steps.

We have created a brand-new resource that has come directly from young people's thoughts and struggles, by breaking the film down into bitesize episodes to watch in class. We suggest; tutor time, PHSCE, Citizenship or even an arts class.

These episodes act as stimuli for discussion, supporting young people to share how they are feeling and what they are thinking. Wiltshire Creative and Salisbury BID are bringing [Window Wanderland](#) to the streets of Salisbury.

Window Wanderland is a national project which brings communities together reducing social isolation and inspiring creativity by transforming streets into magical outdoor galleries. Celebrating the city's diversity by drawing on the themes of Diwali to inspire the artwork to be displayed, the triumph of light over darkness, happiness and positivity.

We are seeking participating groups to create a window display which will be installed in a city window trail between the 1st and 7th November. The artwork should be inspired by the themes of Diwali and provides an ideal opportunity to bring the learning about this celebration to life. It is free to participate. Each group will be supported to create their own window display, supported by resources or a visit from an artist.

Wiltshire and Swindon Cultural Education Partnership

The W&SCEP aims to improve educational, cultural and social outcomes for children and young people through broadening effective interaction between Cultural Organisations (including libraries, arts and heritage) and Schools, in places where it is most needed. It is a response to the Cultural Education Challenge set by Arts Council England.

The partnership is made up of Cultural Organisation representatives and School leaders in across Wiltshire and Swindon. Most recently the partnership awarded over £50,000 in funding to local schools for cultural projects promoting positive health and wellbeing.
